Entry:

Entry will be available via the [Beiter Hit-Miss](#) website from 7pm on 8th August.

Entries close 1 October 2019 or when full.

Local archers: If you are able to shoot the first session it would be appreciated so the second session spaces can be taken by those needing to travel.

Entry won't be confirmed until entry and payment are received by the organisers. A live entry list will be available on the website.

Session preference will be met on a first come first served basis.

Matching Team Shirts/outfits are encouraged! No clothing restrictions, though appropriate sports/non-marking footwear should be worn in the sports hall.




Parking:

University of East Anglia Main Car Park:

Take token on Car Park entry - validate in the Sportspark before departure, then insert into pay machine to authorise for free parking.

Disabled parking:

Sportspark car park - Blue Badges must be displayed. Free parking with ticket validated at the Sportspark Reception.
